Made famous by Beatrix Havergal who established her School of Horticulture for Ladies from 1932 to 1971, it is now home to 20 acres of beautifully landscaped ornamental gardens, a quality plant centre and garden shop, gallery, gift shop, museum and tea shop.

We should arrive in time for morning coffee and light lunches are also available in the Old Dairy and Granary Restaurant.

The cost of the visit is £34.00 per person (£38.00 for non FHS members). However if you are a member of the RHS you can enter the gardens free of charge and you can deduct £10.00 from the above prices. **RHS members must show their valid RHS cards to get free entry, not just a barcode or an app**.

The coach will leave from Regents Park Road (opposite College Farm) at 9.30am and return approximately 5.30pm. **The journey time is approximately 1 and a half hours each way**. There is plenty of parking in neighbouring roads, such as Fitzallan and Allandale.
