Treasurer's Report 2023

2023 ended with under £17,000 available to the Society for capital work to meet ongoing maintenance and approved projects. This is considerably lower than the £32,000 available at the end of last year. The reduction is primarily due to the cost of replacing the piggery canopy at Gordon Road. The wooden structure of the existing canopy had become rotten and was considered beyond repair. The opportunity was taken to improve the environment of the piggery by paving the seating area under the canopy, hedging the perimeter and installing a large water butt to conserve water. The project was completed within budget and on time. The plant sale, the main source of income for the Society after subscriptions, significantly exceeded last year's takings, while the trading hut was marginally down on 2022. After holding subscriptions and charges unchanged for several years, the General Committee considered it prudent to increase service charges for 2024, to offset some of the continuing rise in costs due to inflation. The Committee also anticipated that the plant sale of 2024 would be at a reduced level of income compared with 2023.

Accounts

The accounts which follow are set out over three pages which hopefully will make them easier to read. The figures for 2023 are shown with those of 2022 for comparison. The first page shows the total receipts and payments for both years. They show that expenditure exceeded receipts for 2023. The second page itemises payments over £100. Both water and electricity charges are subject to meter readings. The third page shows the accumulated funds and reserves held by the Society. The page concludes with signatures of the Chair and independent examiner. We are grateful to Jane Healy for continuing to be our independent examiner.
